

# Ad Hoc Housing Element Summary for February 22, 2022 Meeting

On February 22, 2022, the Ad Hoc Housing Element Committee (AHHEC) held a meeting to continue its discussion of the Town's Housing Sites Inventory, a State requirement of the Housing Element. The Committee held its initial discussion on the Housing Sites Inventory on October 18, 2021. That meeting can be viewed [here](#).

The February 22, 2022, meeting opened with public comment (4:18). The Committee then received a presentation from [Woodside Fire Protection District](#) Fire Chief Rob Lindner and Fire Marshall Don Bullard on a comprehensive hazard and risk assessment of the fire district that will designate fire severity zones throughout the district (7:45). Committee and community questions and comments followed.

Staff provided a [presentation](#) on the Housing Sites Inventory and shared the process for Committee's site recommendations, summarized the discussion and key takeaways from the October 18 meeting, presented updated land-use constraints maps and a draft projection of the Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA) by income category. The Committee then held a focused discussion on what sites to consider including in the inventory. The presentation starts at 33:24. Public comment is taken at 2:05:24.

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The Ad Hoc Housing Element Committee's charge is to develop a Housing Element that complies with State law and will be certified while maintaining Town values.
