Summary for February 28, 2022 Meeting

Laura Russell, Planning & Building Director, presented a Housing Element Update General Introduction ([1:03:32](#)) to inform residents new to the process. Adrienne Smith, Senior Planner, gave a presentation on Visualizing Density to help contextualize density/scale of varying representative multi family projects ([1:15:04](#)). She provided a second presentation that included a recap of the Committee's second Housing Sites Discussion held on 2/22/22, including Committee direction to staff and consultants and additional information and maps ([1:25:09](#)).
